The latest industry news offers an encouraging outlook for homebuyers and sellers:

- According to the S&P/Case-Shiller Home Price Indices, home prices rose in October for the ninth straight month.
- According to the National Association of Realtors (NAR), sales of homes \$1 million or more jumped 51 percent in November compared to one year earlier.
- In November, NAR's Pending Home Sales Index rose to its highest level in two and a half years.
- For all of 2012, NAR projects its housing affordability index to be a record high.



## WHAT'S NEW

Congress heard the voice of the real estate industry! With the passing of the bill that averted the "fiscal cliff," Congress made several concessions that are quite favorable toward the housing industry. Included in the bill are a number of real estate tax breaks and credits that most notably include a year-long extension of mortgage cancellation relief for homeowner and sellers, a deduction for mortgage insurance premiums for filers making below \$110,000, as well as a 10 percent tax credit for energy improvements to existing homes.
